## Updated Instructions on Cleaning Spots and Spills with the WoolClean Kit:

**The Proper Role of Absorb-it in the Cleaning Process for Wool Carpets and Rugs.**

Throughout the instructions for spot cleaning are numerous references to “blotting” the wet spill area, both before and after treatment with a spotter. Blotting is important but will never remove ALL the wetness. Only air drying or an absorbent powder can accomplish that. That is where the Absorb-it enters the process.

Understand in the cleaning process when liquids are used as in a washing machine or dish washer the foreign bodies or stains are “liquified” to a degree and occupy spaces within the liquids. When a Rinse cycle takes place much of the “dirt” is removed. Multiple Rinse cycles are standard.

When cleaning wool carpets or rugs the same applies, however the goal is to keep the wool as dry as possible. This is where the Absorb-it comes into the process. The “tiny sponges” can absorb the liquid more completely

- Remove solids with a spoon or spatula if a spill or pet accident as soon as possible.
- Blot stain or spill when wet with a clean dry white cloth to remove as much moisture as possible
- Apply the appropriate Spotter from the Stain Chart to a clean white cloth and blot the stained area....do not rub the stain.
- Using the dampened cloth, blot the area of the stain repeatedly.
- Apply Absorb-it Powder sparingly to the wet area and allow it to absorb the moisture for an hour or more
- Vacuum up the Absorb-it to remove it.
- If stain remains, repeat the process of wetting, blotting, and drying with the Absorb-it powder.
- It is not uncommon for multiple applications to be necessary.
